



## **Curbside List of Acceptable Waste and Recycling**

Only household garbage is picked up at curbside. Bulky items including furniture and appliances can be taken to the Transfer Station.

### **Papers and Fibres**

- Envelopes, flyers, paper bags  
greeting cards, gift wrap
- Catalogues, magazines, phonebooks, paperback books
- Newspapers, office paper and computer paper
- Tissue and cereal boxes, detergent and shoe boxes, egg cartons, cardboard tubes
- Milk and juice cartons, tetra boxes
- Corrugated cardboard that is broken down and no larger than recycling box and tied with string and left next to your recycling box
- Paper coffee cups (Styrofoam NOT accepted)
- Fibre/paper flower trays

### **Containers and Plastics**

- Metal food and beverage cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Aluminum foil and trays
- Empty paint cans that are scraped clean, dry and lid removed
- Plastics with numbers 1,2,3,4,5, or 6

- Bottles: soft drink, water, anti-freeze, milk jugs, detergent, ketchup, mustard windshield washer, syrup, medicine
- Containers: margarine, ice cream, yogurt, peanut butter, deli sandwich shells, clear plastic cooking trays
- Plastic flower trays

## **Not Acceptable**

- Plastic bags
- Blister packs
- Deli or meat wraps
- Styrofoam cups, plates, meat trays and packaging
- Ceramics
- Mirrors
- Light bulbs
- Window glass
- Aerosol cans
- Textiles
- Toys
